

How does the school handle a situation whereby there is a lack of teachers/staff at any point?

We will deploy teachers from other levels/areas within the centre. In addition, principal and administrator will be called in to assist as well. If we are still shorthanded, we would get assistance from our TCH branches.

In terms of hiring teachers, what are the criteria looked at besides qualifications? Does the organization hire only women teachers? How does the organization view racial diversity amongst the staff?

We will look for maturity/experience/poise with good grooming & deportment. We do accept male teachers as well. Racial diversity is definitely a criteria, and we will try to ensure it is balanced.

Are food handlers trained in terms of handling food with hygiene?

Yes, the food handlers (chef and assistants) are trained comprehensively.

Is the caterer providing the food halal certified? Yes.

Are staff certified/trained in administering first aid to children? All staff are first aid certified and trained.

Is that any insurance coverage for the children in the school? Yes, a standard insurance coverage is inclusive in the school fees.



What is the SOP in ensuring that the pickup of a child after school is the proposed parent/guardian What documents do parents need to provide prior to be given this access to pick up his/her child?

A section in the application form would require details of parent/guardian etc, with the personal identification (I/C or passport) to be enclosed for individuals assigned to pick up/drop off the child.



What is health requirement/ guideline /control measurement for admission to the centre i.e. medical letter etc, management on the disease outbreaks i.e H1N1, hand foot mouth disease etc?

An update to all parents will be issued to notify them of the outbreak. Release letter from the doctor/pediatrician certifying child is free from the illness needs to be given before the child comes back to school.

How often will the center be cleaned? (general cleaning)

Daily, and if there is an outbreak of a contagious illness, additional cleaning will be carried out accordingly.
